

## **2007 So. Florida National Black MBA Association (NBMBA) Graduate Scholarship Program**

Scholarships will be awarded to qualified minority business students enrolled in an accredited (AACSB) full-time graduate business program in the U.S. The program must be accredited by the The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. To find out if your school is accredited go to [www.aacsb.edu](http://www.aacsb.edu).

**Applications are due by May 15th.**

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

The NBMBA MBA Scholar Program seeks to identify minority students who will make significant contributions in the field of business both in the public and private sectors. Applicants must be legal residents of Florida, demonstrate academic excellence, exceptional leadership potential and be actively involved in their communities through service to others.

Each year a Florida resident student will receive:

- Scholarship award of \$1,500
- NBMBA membership

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be enrolled in a full-time graduate business program in a college or university in the United States. accredited by the AACSB (AACSB International) at the time of award (Aug. 2007).
- Agree to attend a South Florida NBMBA scholarship reception or other function.
- Become a member of the South Florida NBMBA chapter.

### **Application materials:**

#### *ESSAY*

Essays should be two page, typed (double spaced, 12 point font) that addresses **one** of the topics below:

- What recommendations would you give to Business Schools that want to redesign their recruitment strategies to attract minority candidates? Once enrolled, what resources or programs should be offered to help retain minority students?
- What can African Americans do to become more marketable in the global economy?

**Essays should include a cover page with essay title. DO NOT include your name on the cover page or anywhere in the document. Essays are reviewed "blind."**

#### *RESUME*

Resumes **should not** exceed 2 pages.

#### *TRANSCRIPT(S)*

Official transcripts are required for all college coursework. All other students should submit transcripts from the current graduate program. Transcripts must be received stamped and sealed (no photocopies, computer printouts or faxes will accepted). Application elements should be mailed directly to:
